

Parliamentary Questions

General

- To ask the Secretary of State for Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Affairs, whether his Department has conducted or plans to publish an impact assessment on the decision to reduce the UK's ODA target to 0.3% of GNI by 2027.
- To ask the Chancellor of the Exchequer, what steps she is taking ahead of the upcoming Spending Review to reduce the proportion of ODA spent on in-donor refugee costs.
- To ask the Chancellor of the Exchequer, whether she will publish a clear strategy and timeline to reduce the proportion of ODA allocated to in-donor refugee costs.
- To ask the Secretary of State for Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Affairs, what assessment he has made of the cumulative impact of UK aid reductions on access to healthcare, nutrition, and disease prevention in fragile and conflict-affected states.

Context specific

- To ask the Secretary of State for Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Affairs, what assessment he has made of the impact of reduced UK funding on maternal and child health outcomes in Afghanistan.
- To ask the Secretary of State for Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Affairs, what discussions he has had with international partners regarding the withdrawal of US aid from Afghanistan and its impact on health services.
- To ask the Secretary of State for Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Affairs, what assessment he has made of the long-term health and development consequences of reducing UK nutrition funding in Bangladesh.
